- A scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded after the winning candidate has completed one semester of college, trade school, nursing school, etc, with a grade point average of at least 2.0. The candidate is responsible for sending the official transcript to the scholarship chairperson.
- All applications are due by April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- The selected recipient will be notified by mail by May 15<sup>th</sup>
